

Shirts

- Lakehill T-shirts
- College T-shirts
- Solid colored T-shirts (not white)
- Button down dress shirts
- Golf/Polo shirts
- Hawaiian-type shirts

No writing or pictures of any kind are allowed. Shirts of all types must be modest (no spaghetti straps, no visible cleavage, no visible bra straps, no shoulder straps covering less than 3 inches over the shoulder, nothing backless).

Slacks

- Dockers
- Dress slacks
- Denim pants (not blue jeans)
- Cargo pants
- Capri pants (girls)

Slacks should fit appropriately at the waist – no sagging. Underclothing and tummies may not be visible. No athletic/sweat, or camouflage pants and no tears, holes, or worm spots are allowed. Leggings and jeggings may only be worn under a skirt or dress. Blue jeans may only be worn on Fridays with a Lakehill shirt.

Shorts

- Dressy walking shorts for boys and girls are allowed at any time during the year.

No camouflage, denim, cut offs, or athletic shorts.

Dresses and Skirts

- Variety
- Necklines must be modest (no spaghetti straps, no visible cleavage or bra straps, no shoulder straps covering less than 3 inches over the shoulder, nothing backless). Tummies and underclothing should not be visible. Hemline should be moderate in length (no more than the width of the palm above the knee).

Sweaters

- Cardigan
- V-neck
- Turtle neck
- Crew neck

Sweatshirts

- Lakehill or College sweatshirts
- Solid, plain sweatshirts

Sweatshirts with or without hoods are acceptable. Sweatshirts may not be worn inside out. Hoods may not be worn in the building.

Shoes

- Closed-toe shoes
- Plain athletic shoes
- Sandals
- Boots

The only acceptable shoes of any kind are closed-toe shoes, athletic shoes, heel-strapped sandals, or boots. No slippers, flip-flops, or moccasins. Bare feet are not allowed at any time.

Accessories

- Simple, few in number

Body-piercing jewelry (including tongue and nose rings) is not permitted. Girls may wear pierced earrings. Boys may not wear earrings of any type. No hats, sunglasses, chains, spiked collars or bracelets are allowed. Visible tattoos are not permitted.

Hair

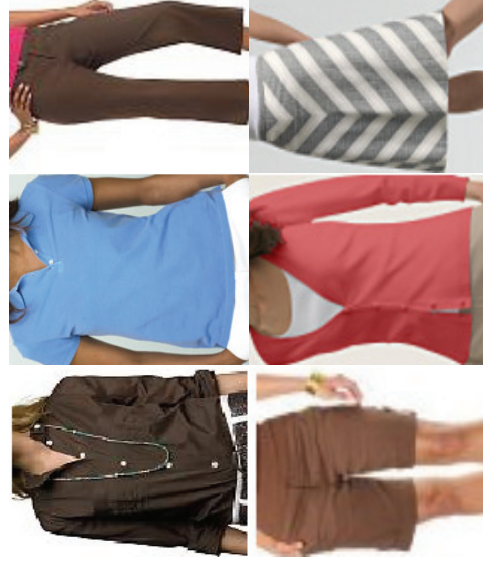
- Natural coloring
- Clean and well groomed
- Boys – not below the collar

Boys may not wear ponytails. Neither boys nor girls may wear spikes, cutout designs, or shaved scalps. Hairline should not cover eyes.

Hygiene

- Clothes should be neat and clean.
- Boys must be clean-shaven.
