Official Contest Rules

Chili is defined for this contest as any kind of meat (venison or other game meats are allowed, but must be specifically highlighted in the ingredients list), or beans, or combination cooked with chili peppers, various spices, and other ingredients. Both meat and vegetarian chilis are acceptable, but will not be judged separately.

All entries must be pre-cooked. There will be no preparation area available.

Each contestant must cook a **minimum of two quarts of chili** to be stored in a crock pot or other container to keep the chili warm. Please bring a ladle or serving utensil. If you have special toppings, you will need to supply those as well. (Special toppings will not be included in the judging round). Lakehill will provide each contestant with a power supply, tasting cups, spoons, and napkins.

Each contestant will be provided a space to set-up crock pot and chili tasting cups. Contestants may decorate their presentation area if desired.

All chili will be judged on the following criteria:

Taste

Visual Appeal

Aroma/Texture

Set up begins at : 0 p.m. Contestants should ready for judging at 6: 0 p.m. and will serve their chili from 6: 0 until 7: 0 p.m.

Two Awards will be presented:

Grand Champion Award – Trophy will be awarded for the best overall chili, according to the judging panel.

People's Choice Award – Trophy will be awarded to the contestant whose chili received the most votes during the chili tasting period.
