**Position Title: Head Athletic Trainer and Sports Medicine Elective Teacher**

**Primary Purpose:**

This position administers athletic training services to the school community and will provide support to the school health and wellness coordinator on athletic injuries. These services include, but are not limited to, school screenings, injury prevention programs, injury assessment, and treatment and case management of injured athletes undergoing rehabilitation. The ideal candidate will also develop, coordinate and implement a comprehensive student athletic training program for Lakehill through teaching a high school sports medicine elective.

**Major Responsibilities and Duties:**

- Oversees and implements the prevention, assessment, management, treatment, rehabilitation, and counseling of athletic injuries and conditions affecting athletes and school community
- Provide athletic training services for all home athletic contests. Attendance at practices and away competitions may be necessary for certain sports as well
- Teach a sports medicine elective in order to develop and implement a student athletic training program for the school
- Act as liaison between family physicians and specialists, the school administration, athletes and their parents
- Maintain accurate records of TAPPS required RankOne forms, injuries and treatments as well as an inventory of sports medicine supplies
- Maintains all necessary professional certifications, assist the athletic director as requested and perform other duties as may be assigned

Lakehill Preparatory School is a K-12 college preparatory school in the heart of Lakewood, within easy reach of all areas of Dallas. It houses classrooms for over 400 students as well as a gymnasium, a cafeteria, two libraries, numerous science and computer labs, and an auditorium. The Roger L. Perry campus, located just four miles from the Main Campus, is home to a premier athletic complex and a state-of-the-art, LEED-certified environmental science center. The athletic complex includes facilities for football, soccer, baseball, softball and tennis as well as a field house with a weight room, coaches office and locker rooms. Lakehill competes at the TAPPS 3-A level and has state championship caliber programs in cross country, 6-man football, volleyball, basketball, winter soccer, baseball, softball, track and field, tennis and golf.
